STARDUSTER. The code name used by U.S. Army Sergeant Edward J. Skylar, born in Burlingame, California. Skylar was a circus trapeze artist before enlisting and becoming an Airborne Ranger. The acrobatic skills he displayed as a helicopter assault trooper caught the attention of Duke, who thought his skill would work well with a JUMP jetpack and recruited him for G.I. Joe, where he served before the team's shut down in 1994. Today, like many Joes, he is a reserve member of the team. Starduster served in England and Ireland during the conflict known as World War III. One of many Joes listed on World War III member assignment map first seen in AE #28.
